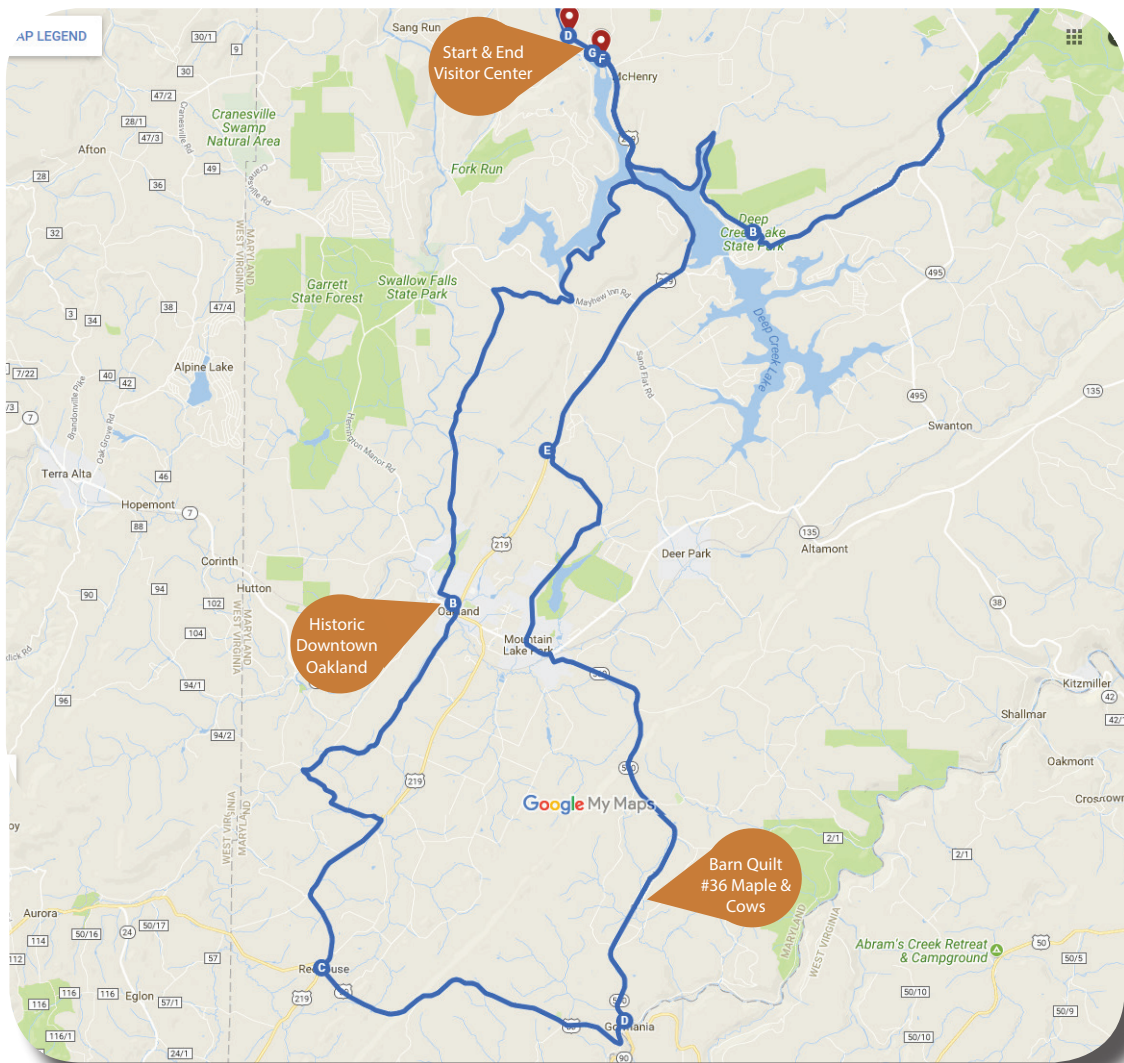


FALL FOLIAGE DRIVING TOURS 2023

56th Annual Autumn Glory Festival

October 11 - 15, 2023

Extended Tour Total Time: Approximately 1 hour, 30 minutes, Total Distance: 56 miles



Directions:

1. Start at the Garrett County Visitors Center at 15 Visitors Center Drive, McHenry, MD 21541
2. Turn right onto US-219 S
3. Turn right onto Lake Shore Dr
4. Slight right onto Bray School Rd

5. Turn left onto Oakland Sang Run Rd
 - You will pass by #39 Friendship Star Barn Quilt
6. Continue onto N Bradley Ln
7. Turn left onto W Center St
8. Turn right at the 1st cross street onto N Bartlett St
9. Turn left onto E Liberty St
 - Visit the historic town of Oakland - three museums, art galleries, farmer's market (on Wednesdays & Saturdays), quaint shops, and eateries.
10. Head southeast on E Liberty St toward S 2nd St
11. Turn right onto S 2nd St
12. Turn left onto E Alder St
13. Turn right at the stoplight onto S 3rd St (Rt. 219)
14. Continue straight to stay on S 3rd St
15. Continue onto Underwood Rd
16. Turn left to stay on Underwood Rd
 - You will pass #26 Goose Tracks Barn Quilt
17. Turn left onto Mansfield Rd
18. Turn right onto US-219 S
19. Head southwest on US-219 S toward US-50 E
20. Turn left at the 1st cross street onto US-50 E
21. Turn left onto MD-560 N
 - You will pass #36 Maple & Cows Barn Quilt
22. Continue north on MD-560 N toward Allen Marple Dr
23. At the stop sign, turn right onto Paul St
24. Cross the railroad tracks and turn left onto MD-135 W at the stoplight.
25. Turn right onto G St
26. Slight right onto Deer Park Ave
27. Continue onto Broadford Rd
28. Turn left onto Kings Run Rd
29. Turn right onto US-219 N
30. Turn left into the McHenry Plaza
31. Turn left onto Visitors Center Drive returning to the Garrett County Visitors Center.
